John Duncan McGee passed on Monday, November 18, 2024; just one month after his 84th birthday. He passed as he wished, in his home on the farm he worked hard to earn. He was born in Lamesa, Texas on October 18, 1940, the eldest of 8 siblings. At four years old, he began picking cotton with his parents—beginning his life-long work ethic. Through this upbringing, he dreamed of having his own farm. After graduating high school, he eventually made his way to California. There he met Carolyn Sue Henson, his wife of 63 years. They soon had their only child, a daughter named Lori Jean McGee in late 1961. Although he enjoyed the creature comforts of California, he still dreamed of owning a farm. They moved to Oklahoma in the 1970s where John accomplished his dream of owning a farm. He constantly worked to provide for his family and sustain income for his farm. He made sure that none of his family ever had to worry about food, clothes, or shelter. He rarely took vacations and had little vices except for the numerous sweets he'd have scattered around the house.

He is survived by his wife, Carolyn Sue McGee; his brothers, Virgil, Gordon Jr., and James; his sisters Novella Rattan, Norena McClesky, and Kelly Tice; his only child, Lori Jean McGee; three grandchildren: Tiara Blue and her husband Christopher Blue, Starlet Etheridge, and Christina O'Conner and her husband Colten O'Conner; and his four great-grandchildren: Lane Blue, Dawson Blue, Vivian O'Conner, and Ellie O'Conner.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Gordon and Eva McGee, and his brother Jerry McGee.
