She raised goats after she retired and always had a garden full of the best tomatoes, which she was always willing to share.

Kathy was preceded in death by Willis D. Stewart, her husband of fifty-four years, her parents, one sister, Carolyn Litchfield and two brothers, John and Clarence Wayne and a granddaughter Christina.
