After a courageous battle with cancer, Kelsey passed away on July 11, 2025, at the age of 39 years, 2 months, and 26 days. She was surrounded by her loving family and friends in the comfort of her home.

Kelsey and her family moved to Sulphur, Oklahoma, at the beginning of her sixth-grade year.

She graduated from Sulphur High School in 2004 and went on to earn two degrees from

Oklahoma State University in 2009. She later completed her education in Physical Therapist

Assistant (PTA) school and discovered her passion for home health care.

Kelsey's dedication,

compassion, and joyful spirit endeared her to every patient she served.

Kelsey was known for her spunky and determined drive, a spirit that carried her through every

season of life — from her school years to her career in home health, and especially during her

courageous fight with cancer. Her resilience, energy, and infectious smile left a lasting impact on
