After graduating from Norman High School in 2005, she attended Oklahoma City Community College and graduated in 2014 from East Central University with a bachelor's degree in math. Kendra was the first contestant on stage in the episode and went only a few dollars over on her showcase. Kendra recently began painting classes, producing several works for her home. She also loved to travel, particularly to the beach. She hoped to live to on a beach someday. She was a member of the Eastern Star and Alpha Gamma Delta sorority.

Kendra is preceded in death by her grandparents, Ollen and Joyce Parker; brother, Joshua Wayne Parker; great-grandfather, Francis Parker.

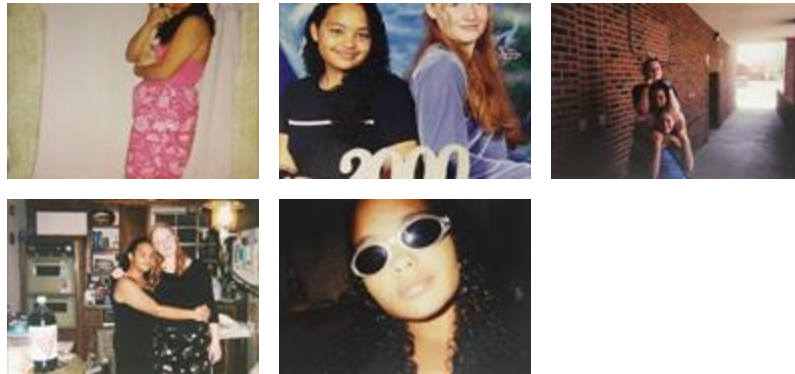
