Kenneth M. Lowe, 88, of Bromide, Okla., passed away on February 19, 2024, in Atoka, Okla.

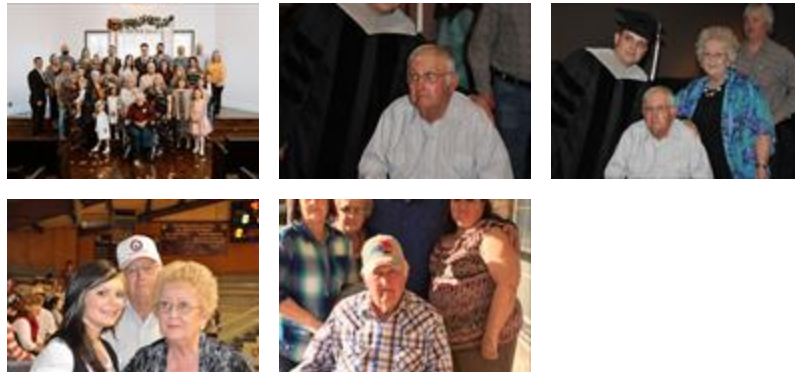
