Funeral Services for Kenneth R. Cole, 80, of Connerville, Oklahoma will be held on Wednesday, June 15th, 2011 at 11:00 a. m. in the First Assembly of God Church in Tishomingo with Rev.Lyn Gaskey officiating. Interment will follow in the Connerville Cemetery. Mr. Cole passed away on June 13th, at the Mercy Memorial Health Center in Ardmore, Oklahoma.

Kenneth was born on April 27th, 1931 in Connerville to Murman Dowell "Dick" Cole and Mary Opal Winkler Cole. He graduated from Pontotoc High School in Pontotoc, Oklahoma and married Elsie Gray on October 8th, 1949 in Gainesville, Texas.
