Bernie "L.B." Lowe, a resident of Norman, OK, was born on March 31, 1923 in Keota, OK to Artie (Blevins) and D.C. "Doc" Lowe. He passed away in Norman, OK on January 5, 2015 at the age of 91. L.B. grew up in Keota and spent most of his time there until being drafted into World War II. During the war L.B. was a part of the U.S. Army involved in battles and campaigns in Northern France, The Rhineland, Central Europe, and Normandy. The last ten years he moved closer to his daughter and lived in Pauls Valley at the Willows assisted living center, then to Norman, OK to the Veteran's Center.
