



Lahoma Byrns Brisco

July 7, 1921 - September 28, 2012

Graveside Services for Mrs. Lahoma Byrns Brisco, 91, of Fillmore, Oklahoma will be held on Tuesday, October 2nd, 2012 at 2:00 p. m. at the Green Meadows Cemetery in Atoka, Oklahoma with Dr. Rex Clayton officiating, with a Eulogy by Ms. Lisa Shephard. Mrs. Brisco passed away on September 28th, 2012 in Allen, Texas.

Lahoma was born on July 7th, 1921 in Ranger, Texas to Myron Allen Byrns and Orena (Steel) Byrns. She was married to R. B. Brisco in Durant, Oklahoma on May 16th, 1940 and he preceded her in death in 1997. She was also preceded in death by her parents and fifteen siblings.

Mrs. Brisco is survived by five children: Susan Hamilton and husband Paul of Tishomingo, Oklahoma, Deborah Flowers and husband Dennis of Fillmore, David Brisco and wife Brenda of Duncan, Oklahoma, Pam Pullen and husband Mark of Davis, Oklahoma and Patricia Brisco of Allen, Texas; thirteen grandchildren; twenty-two great-grandchildren; her sister, Patsy Brakebill of Nacogdoches, Texas; and many nieces and nephews.

Mrs. Brisco was raised in McCutain and Atoka counties. During WWII, she worked in a war factory as a "Rosie the Riveter" and as a motor pool secretary. She was a key punch operator and secretary to the Superintendent of Schools in Anchorage, Alaska for four years. She received her BS degree

in Education in 1967 from Southeastern Oklahoma State University and taught business and elementary education at Milburn Schools until her retirement in 1982. She and her family moved to Fillmore in 1971, where she spent the remaining years of her life. She was also a member of the United Methodist Church.
