He was a great father and always worked hard to provide for his family. He always had "hunny do's " that Maxine needed done. He built fish ponds, bridges and flower beds. Whatever she wanted , he always tried.

Lindell family spent many summer vacations at lake Murray in the conversion school bus camper (long before it was cool) but lots of memories were made. He enjoyed his grandkids and great grandkids. They took trips to the beach in the RV and hunted for shells and made great memories. He loved to play dominoes and I know he played a game with family first thing.

He got to share the last year of his life with his daughters Darla and Dana,

splitting time between Ada and Wynnewood. He was loved and will be missed by many.
