Loretta Jean Faulk, was born September, 6th, 1942 in Rush Springs, OK to Roy Carpenter and Nona Lee (Gardner) Carpenter. Loretta passed away on March, 27th, 2022 at the age of 79 years, 6 months, and 21 days.

After Graduating from U.S. Grant High School Loretta worked at the Western Electric Company.
