“ My sister Lorraine.....suffered so many, many years with mental illness.....bi-polar disease with behavior disorders and so many other diagnoses..... In these later years - she suffered so much physically.....one medical problem after the next. She moved from facility to facility for so many years.....



When she was feeling well -- you would never know that she suffered from mental illness.....my sister was an intelligent, beautiful, loving, good, kind, considerate, empathetic and God-fearing human being.....

We exchanged many cards and letters over the years.....She always - always - always - always expressed to me how much she missed me and how much she wanted to see me....how much she loved me.....how much she loved the family and missed the family.....and she asked me so many times if I would come and get her and bring her to visit dad and mom.....

I said no to my sister so many times --- I've lost count. I knew my father and mother were unable to cope with my sister's illness in such close time frames.....and so I had to make excuses not to go get my sister to bring her to dad and mom's house.....

The truth is - it was VERY difficult to me to be with my sister for any length of time -- it was impossible to know what sort of mood she would be in and what she would do next....she could get so agitated and so angry within a second after being so happy and fun loving.....

She lived inside a mental hell.....for so long.....

She evangelized to every one she met about the love of Jesus.....about Our Blessed Mother.....about all the angels and saints.....She loved God.....so much!

My sister - loved people --- over the years that she spent in nursing home facilities.....it wouldn't be uncommon to see her reach out to an elderly person in need and help them....she did this ALL THE TIME.....what a gentle - gentle - loving soul my sister Lorraine had.....

When she hugged me -- I could feel the love she had for me....I cried every time she hugged me because I loved her so muchand I knew she suffered so much.....and I knew I could be a better sister ---- a more loving sister to her and I wasn't.....

So many emotions would flood through me when I hugged my sister Lorraine.....or each time I wrote any of the many letters and cards I wrote to her.....I would cry and cry and cry

My sister's photo here.....is the same photo I have of her next to this laptopI see her all the time - every day.....I ask God to watch over her.....as I know HE does! I tell her how much I love her.....over and over and over and over.....

Before my sister became ill.....she could sing so beautifully --- she dressed like a model --- she always wore her hair and makeup so stylish --- she was one of the top drama students in her high school class in California.....what a personality!.....She was amazing!

I have this memory of how she used to imitate the lion's voice in the wizard of oz.....she used to make me laugh so hard.....

I don't have many happy memoriesmy sister became ill so early on.....I saw the illness moreso when she was about 17 after my niece Charity Linnette Aglialoro was born..... (Charity passed away May 12, 1996).....

I clicked on to this website today when I found out one of our beloved parishioners passed away and this is the funeral home that will do the services.....

I saw nothing written here about my sister Lorraine Ann Aglialoro except for one woman that lit a candle.....I can't tell you how much emotion my sister's passing has brought up again at this moment.....

Thank God for my parents---they loved my sister Lorraine unconditionally for the 57 years she was here.....Their arms - their hearts have always - always been OPEN to my sister Lorraine.....and for this I am so - so thankful.
