Luanne Dillard, Wynnewood, was born April 26, 1952, to Thomas Franklin and Ruby Ella (Howard) Dillard. She passed away at OU Medical Center on September 13, 2018, at the age of 66years 4 months 17 days

Luanne graduated from Wynnewood High School with the Class of 1970. She completed her Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree from the University of Oklahoma in 1976 and began working in the Neonate Intensive Care Unit (NICU) at Children's Hospital in Oklahoma City, where she remained for the next 25 years. She most recently worked at Arbuckle Memorial Hospital in Sulphur, OK, until her retirement in February 2018.

Luanne was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Wynnewood. She was preceded in death by her father, Thomas Dillard, and by her best friend, Faye Buchanan.
