LuCretia Ann Thompson age 77, passed away in the comfort of her own home in Bromide, OK on April 27, 2019. 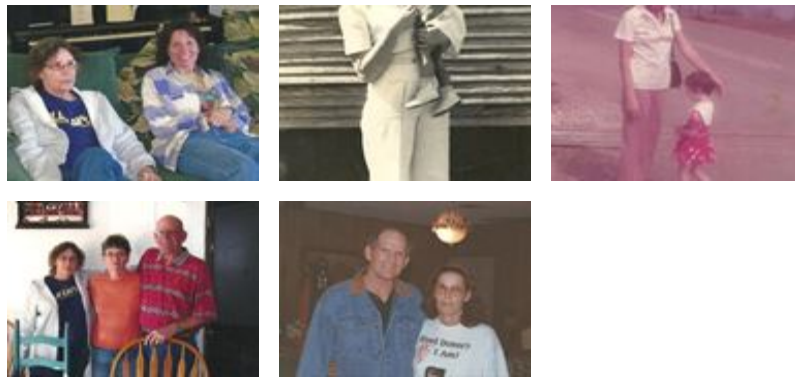
