M.A. "Mel" Rennie, Jr., a resident of Wynnewood, OK was born September 5, 1927 in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma to Lillian Trone and M.A. "Fred" Rennie. He passed away August 30, 2009 at Wynnewood, Oklahoma at the age of 81 years 11 months and 25 days. He was married to Betty Lucille (Williams) Rennie, at Wynnewood, OK on March 26, 1949. He served his country in the U.S. Navy. He was also a Past City Councilman and Mayor of the City of Wynnewood, past Exalted Ruler of the Benevolent and Protective order of the Elk, and Past Wynnewood Volunteer Fireman and Fire Chief. He worked for the Kerr McGee Refinery for many years before retiring, owned and operated Ace Bail Bonds in Pauls Valley, and owned and operated the Dairy Cream in Wynnewood. He was preceded in death by Parents, Wife - Betty Lucille Williams Rennie on October 30, 2007, and a Brother - Robert T. Rennie.
