Mary Elizabeth Bacon, a resident of Sulphur was born June 4, 1917 in Yuma Colorado to Marie Alice (Fletcher) and Frank Carl Goulding. She passed away November 23, 2006 at Sulphur, Oklahoma at the age of 89 years 5 months and 19 days. After the death of her mother Mrs. Bacon was raised by her grandparents George P. and Minnie Goulding in Butler, OK. She graduated Butler High School School in 1934. She and Chancie G. Young were married in Russell, Kansas in 1937. During World War II she worked as a riveter at Douglas Aircraft in OKC. Later she worked for a manufacturing company that produced the first type of folding carriers that were used by the Humpty Dumpty grocery stores in OKC. She was married to Wesley Frank Bacon at OKC, OK on May 15, 1950 and they moved to the Dolese Company housing at Big Canyon, OK. She was a member of Central Baptist Church where she accepted Christ as her savior. She loved to fish in the Washita River and Lake Texoma. She was preceded in death by Her parents, her husband Wesley Frank Bacon on February 21, 1990, two sisters, and one brother.
