Maxine Lannom, a resident of Sulphur was born August 14, 1923 in the Red Oak Community North of Sulphur, Oklahoma to Amos Luther & Annie Julie (Sparks) Arms She passed away Thursday April 6, 2017 at Ardmore, Oklahoma at the age of 93 years 7 months and 22 days. Maxine was the ninth of eleven children.

She grew up in the Red Oak Community where she attended school until 7th grade when she transferred to Sulphur High School. After her marriage to Harold Lannom at Austin, TX on April 23, 1943, they lived in Platt National Park, where Harold was employed. They moved into the Sulphur city limits in 1957. She worked for her sister and brother-in-law, James & Opal Howe, and helped to open Sooner Foods where she worked for 15 years..She had worked as a volunteer for the Callaway Nursing Home while her mother was a resident there.

Maxine was a lifelong member of the Vinita Ave Church of Christ.

She had been a member of the Oaklawn OHCE for over 60 years, the Historical Society, and a former member of Artist of the Arbuckles, and the Firemans Auxillary

Maxine was a longtime cancer survivor.

She was preceded in death by her parents, husband Harold on February 9, 1997.

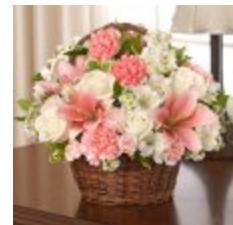
