Melvin Otis Brown, a resident of Edmond, was born February 16, 1911, in Cushing, Oklahoma to Enoch Leander & Nancy Anna (Allison) Brown. He passed away Monday, February 23, 2004 at Edmond, Oklahoma at the age of 93 years. He married Hazel Inez Hensley Brown on May 23, 1935 at Sulphur, Oklahoma.
