Melvin Pidgue was born on November 6, 1928 in Binger, Oklahoma to Clarence E. Pidgue and Ethel S. (Bone) Pidgue. He grew up in that area and later served in the United States Army, 45th Division, during the Korean Conflict. Melvin lived many years in Texas and retired from the City of Dallas as a heavy equipment operator. He moved to Johnston County in 1984 and has lived here since that time.

He was preceded in death by his parents; a brother, Kenneth and his sister, Juanita Russell.
