



## Mildred V. Cobb

October 5, 1922 - January 13, 2012

Mildred V. Cobb, a resident of Sulphur was born October 5, 1922 in Sulphur, Oklahoma to Ernest Donal & Willie Lee Thornhill Vernon ( both her parents were members of pioneer families who moved to Sulphur after 1900 and lived there all of their lives). She passed away Friday January 13, 2012 at Sulphur, Oklahoma at the age of 89 years 3 months and 8 days.

She attended school in Sulphur where she graduated High School in 1940. She attended East Central State College in Ada where she met her future husband Truman Cobb. They were married May 12, 1943 in San Bernardino, California while he was serving in the U.S. Air Force. She graduated from East Central in 1944 and taught in Sulphur school system in 1944-1945 while her husband was over seas. After WWII they moved to Ada where Truman worked for an insurance agency.

They moved to Sulphur in 1957 and established the Cobb Insurance Agency, which included accounting and income tax preparation. Both were active in the business. She was also active in the ministry as her husband pastored local Southern Baptist Churches for about 35 years, including almost 24 years at Hickory Baptist Church.

She was a member of First Baptist Church. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, Truman Cobb, on December 14, 2008, sister: Pauline Pinkstaff, brother: W.L. Vernon.
