Patricia Ann (Denney) Reese, age 83, passed away peacefully on December 3, 2024. She was born on March 22, 1941, in County Line, Oklahoma, to William Raymond and Dorothy Lee (Pierce) Denney.

A 1959 graduate of Sulphur High School, Patricia was known for her deep love of family, her caring and generous heart, and her willingness to forgive. Everything she did was motivated by her desire to help her family in any way possible. She cherished bringing her loved ones together, often entertaining them with games like Wahoo on a board lovingly made by her daddy, "Papaw".

Patricia had a zest for life and a wonderful sense of humor. She enjoyed playing paper bingo and jokingly referred to her contributions as donations to "The Chickasaw Pension Plan." A devoted sports fan, Patricia cheered for the OKC Thunder, the Oklahoma Sooners, and the Tampa Bay Buccaneers, especially during Baker Mayfield's tenure. Her adventurous spirit then led her to Andros Island in the Bahamas, where she worked on the Navy base in the BX. In 1995, she moved to Brandon, Florida, to continue her bookkeeping career with an accounting service. Later, she returned to Oklahoma to be with

her parents in Woodward until their passing. She eventually settled back in Sulphur to be close to her children and grandchildren.
