Funeral Services for Mrs. Patsey Ferris Martin, 74, of Amarillo, Texas (formerly of Tishomingo, Oklahoma) will be held on Monday, March 11th, 2013 at 10:00 a. m. in the Clark Funeral Chapel in Tishomingo with Rev. Tony Folger officiating. Interment will follow in the Connerville Cemetery in Connerville, Oklahoma. Mrs. Martin passed away on March 6th, 2013 in the BSA Hospice facility in Amarillo.
