Pauline Covington was born December 9, 1918, in Woodford, Oklahoma, to Loretta and Ben Pierce. She passed from this life on Tuesday October 27, 2009 in Sulphur, Oklahoma at the age of 90. She attended various schools, but graduated from Wynnewood High School, where she played on the basketball team. She met and married the love of her life, Robert Archie Covington on January 3, 1942. Archie was a true cowboy, both in his daily life and on the rodeo circuit. For three decades, Pauline thoroughly enjoyed going with him traveling the PRCA circuit. For many years, they made their annual pilgrimage to the Cheyenne Frontier Days Rodeo. Archie preceded her in death on February 11, 1996.

Pauline was an excellent cook and had numerous requests for her recipes. She was probably most famous for her chow-chow and sweet dill pickles. She always prepared her family's favorite delicious chicken and dressing during the holiday season. Earlier in life, she was an expert seamstress. She also crocheted and was very proud of her beautiful afghans.

This classy, sweet lady had lived in the Wynnewood area for many, many years and was a member of the First Baptist Church.

Along with her husband, she was preceded in death by her parents, seven brothers, and three sisters.

She is survived by one sister, Katharine Burdick of Ardmore, many nieces and nephews whom deeply cared
For “Aunt Pauline”, and a whole host of very good friends.
