



F.M. Pete Jones

F.M. Pete Jones, a resident of Sulphur was born December 25, 1921 in Sulphur, Oklahoma to Forbus Marcus and Forrest (Lance) Jones. He passed away Monday April 1, 2013 at Sulphur, Oklahoma at the age of 91 years 3 months and 6 days. Pete had lived in the Sulphur area all his life, graduating from Sulphur High School in 1940. He served in the Army Air Force during WWII, flying a C-47 while in North Africa and Italy. Pete and LaWanda Brassfield were married on Nov. 29, 1952 in Davis, Oklahoma. He worked as a rural postal carrier for Rt 2 until his retirement. Pete also operated a dairy and was a cattle rancher on the land that has been in the family for over 100 years. He was preceded in death by his parents; a brother: Ben Jones; and a sister: Oleta Silvers.
