



Raymond Elbert Franklin

March 21, 1917 - September 8, 2003

Raymond Elbert Franklin, a resident of Norman, was born March 21, 1917, near Colorado City, TX to James Samuel and Ida May (McCollough) Franklin. He passed away Monday, September 08, 2003, at Norman, Oklahoma at the age of 86 years. He grew up around Colorado City, TX where he attended and graduated from high school. Mr. Franklin served in the Marine Corp. from 1940-1945 during World War II. He was married to Verdeana (Hughes) Franklin at Abernathy, TX on December 16, 1946. He lived around Brownwood, TX where he was a "farmer by desire", and a "truck driver by necessity". Mr. and Mrs. Franklin later moved to Jasper, TX where they resided before moving to Norman, OK in 2002. He was a member of the Tanglewood Baptist Church in Jasper, TX. Mr. Franklin was preceded in death by his parents; a daughter, Martha Franklin; 3 sisters, and 4 brothers.

Services for Raymond Franklin will be 10:00 AM on Wednesday, September 10, 2003 at the First Baptist Church of Sulphur, OK. Interment will follow at Oaklawn Cemetery.
