March 31, 1913 - November 22, 2014

A life well lived is a beautiful thing. Retha Hines Daniels Bizzini lived a beautiful life. She was born on March 31, 1913, to Effie Mae Webster Hines and Robert Harrison Hines, and passed from this life on November 22nd, 2014.

In those one hundred and one years, Retha accomplished so much. She graduated at sixteen from Pauls Valley High School, in 1929, and then attended Business College in Oklahoma City. She married Tom Daniels on February 15, 1930. They raised four girls: Debby, Barbara, Alice, and Joy. Through the years of struggle during The Depression, they left their home in Oklahoma and moved their growing family to California. They lived in Seaside, California, where Retha owned and operated Daniels Diner from 1949 to 1960. In 1971, they returned to Oklahoma, where Retha worked as a bookkeeper for twenty years at livestock auction barns in Pauls Valley, Sulphur, and Ada.

Retha was one of fourteen children and was preceded in death by her parents, six brothers, Argus, Jake, Charley, Thomas, Snow, Shorty, Bobby Joe; and four sisters-in-law: Lois, Ruth, Dorothy, and Barbara Joan. She was also preceded in death by four sisters: Inez, Geneva, Bessie May, and Lucille (Pat) and six brothers-in-law: Red Wright, Zollie McCray, Kenneth Stidham, John Hargis, Homer Mays, and Raymond Taylor. She was also preceded in death by her daughters, Joy and Alice, as well as her husband of sixty three years, Tom.

She will be missed by her sons-in-law, David, Mitch, and John, her church family, her sisters, June and Effie Lee, her children, grand children, great grand children, great great grand children, great great great grandchildren, nieces, nephews, and countless others.
