Funeral Services for Mrs. Roberta "Bertie" Cargill, 83, of Milburn, Oklahoma will be held on Saturday, February 1st, 2014 at 10:00 a. m. at the Church of the Nazarene in Fillmore, Oklahoma with Rev. Mrs. Cargill passed away on January 26th, 2014 at the Medical Center of Southeastern Oklahoma in Durant.

She graduated from high school in Portales, New Mexico and married Lee Cargill on September 9th, 1949 in Pampa, Texas.
