Ronald Earl Little, a resident of Sulphur was born June 17, 1934 in Hickory, Oklahoma to Hubert Leroy & Ina (Walters) Little. He passed away Sunday November 5, 2017 at Sulphur, Oklahoma at the age of 83 years 4 months and 18 days. He was married to Freda Sue (Moore) Little at Sulphur, OK on September 30, 1956. Ron grew up in Hickory where he graduated from High School. He graduated from Cameron University and later from Oklahoma State University with a Degree in Animal Husbandry. Ron obtained his masters degree from Shippensburg University in Pennsylvania with a MBA in Business Administration. He was a Viet Nam Veteran serving in the US Army He retired in 1985 as a Colonel, and returned to Sulphur. Ron began working at OSD in 1986 where he worked as business manager until he retired in April 1996. Ron raised Hereford Cattle.

He was a member of Crossway Baptist Church, Sulphur Rotary Club, Murray County Tractor Association, Sulphur Masonic Lodge #144, American Legion #148, and Ardmore MOAA.

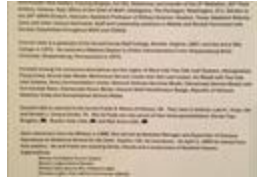
