Funeral Services for Rev. Roy Carpenter, Jr., 91, of Tishomingo, Oklahoma will be held on Monday, September 3rd, 2012 at 10:00 a. m. in the First Baptist Church at Ravia, Oklahoma with Rev. Kenneth McCarthick officiating, assisted by Rev. Roger Hartwell. Interment will follow in the Rose Hill Cemetery in Wapanucka, Oklahoma. Rev. Carpenter passed away on August 29th, 2012 at the Integris Marshall Memorial Hospital in Madill, Oklahoma.

Roy was born on February 24th, 1921 in Verden, Oklahoma to Roy Carpenter, Sr. and Cora (McKee) Carpenter. He grew up and attended school in that area and later met and married, Nora Gardner on August 1st, 1941 in Marlow, Oklahoma. Roy served in the United States Navy during WWII and after his honorable discharge, went to work as an airplane inspector for the Federal Aviation Administration. He traveled to many parts of the country while with the FAA and retired with 25 years of service. He was also an ordained minister and pastored many churches to include, the First Baptist Church in Ravia and the Crystal Church, near Lane, Oklahoma.

Roy was preceded in death by his parents' his wife Nona in 1997; four brothers, Harold, Claude, Melvin and Kenneth and three sisters, Marie, Rose and Beatrice.
