Roy Coleman Thompson, a resident of Sulphur was born March 12, 1921 in Paoli, Oklahoma to Jess C. and Jessie Irene (Alexander)Thompson. He passed away Monday March 11, 2013 at Norman, Oklahoma at the age of 91 years 11 months and 29 days. Roy had lived in several areas including Oklahoma City, Oklahoma and San Antonio, Texas before moving to Sulphur in 1984. He served in the Army Air Corps during WWII and in the Air Force during Korea, and flew in 33 combat missions during WWII. Roy and Marcelene Chisum were married on Dec. 29, 1946 in Turlock, California. She preceded him in death on May 23, 1999. Roy later married Wilma Chisum McCarthy in November of 2000. Roy was retired from the civil service at Kelly Air Force Base in San Antonio, Texas and was a member of the First Freewill Baptist Church.
