



## Sandra Jo Wolf

June 22, 1948 - January 30, 2022

Sandra Jo Good Wolf passed away on January 29, 2022 at the age of 73. She was born on June 22, 1948 in Wynnewood, Oklahoma to James and Olive Belle Good. Sandy spent her childhood growing up in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma until her family moved to Farmington, New Mexico in 1962. Then to Hobbs, New Mexico in 1964, where Sandy attended high school. In 1966, shortly after her senior year, she married James Calvin Fore Jr. and they made their home in Hobbs, NM. They started a family right away and went on to have three children: Trey, Leigh Ann and Gary. While the children were still young, she moved back to Oklahoma and worked at Kellwood in Pauls Valley making men's pants for Sears. She eventually remarried and was well known around Wynnewood as Sandy King. While her children were growing up, she loved watching Gary play sports, and Trey and Leigh Ann in the band, she was always there cheering them on. One of her proudest moments is when Leigh Ann became a baton twirler, her sophomore year for the Wynnewood High School band. During the fall of 1983, on Homecoming night, Leigh Ann was tragically killed in a car accident at age 15. From that point on, she has always talked about the day when she would get to see her baby girl once again in heaven. Sandy kept herself busy and joined the local women's bowling league in Pauls Valley. She went on to travel to several states across the country, bowling in tournaments as a pro amateur bowler. During the mid to late 80's, she owned and operated Big Country Truck Stop and Restaurant in Wynnewood. She was very involved in the truck driving community and

became a truck driver herself after closing the restaurant. In the 90's, her grandchildren started being born and that became her absolute favorite hobby. She was Granny, Grandma Sandy, and Granny Great to not only her own grand children, but to anyone else that needed a Grandparent in their lives. Her grandchildren were her world and she made sure they all knew they were special to her. Sandy married Steve Wolf in October 1997. Shortly after, she stopped driving a truck and used her experience in the trucking industry to start working from home as a dispatcher for WW Petroleum out of Macon, Missouri. She did that until she retired in 2013. After her retirement, she focused on spending time with family. She recently lost her son Trey in July of 2021. After losing two of her children, she was more than ready to see them again and be in the presence of her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

She is survived by her husband Steve Wolf of 24 years, son Gary Fore, his wife Lou Ann of Fort Gibson, OK. Bonus daughter Michelle Roady and her husband Rod of Davis, OK. 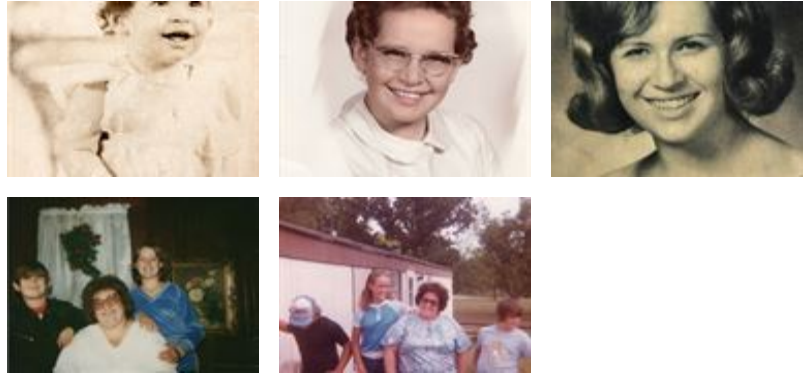
