Seth A. Hensley, III, was born on October 16, 1950 in Overton, Texas to Rosemary (Ball) and Seth Hensley, II. He passed away on Saturday, December 16, 2023 in Norman, Oklahoma at the age of 73 years and 2 months. Seth lived in several areas while growing up, graduating from Anadarko High School in 1969.
