Sharon Jean West passed away peacefully Saturday, March 8, 2025, at Texoma Medical Center in Denison, TX. She was born in Tishomingo, OK, November 26, 1949. She attended Tishomingo Schools up to her graduation in 1968. Sharon went on to further her education at Southern Oklahoma Technology Center, where she received her license as an LPN.

She served as a nurse for 17 years at Johnston Memorial Hospital in Tishomingo before transitioning to her 13-year role at the Chickasaw Nation Medical Center in Tishomingo, where she stayed until her retirement. She married Ronnie West on April 26, 1969 and was married 55 years up to her passing.

She dedicated her life to caring for both her family and her community. 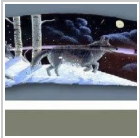
