Sulphur, Oklahoma at the age of 56 years 4 months and 8 days.

Sheri grew up in El Paso. She graduated from Andress High School in El Paso, Texas.

She was the featured twirler with the band, and was the only twirler the Andress band

ever had. Sheri was a speech language pathologist. She earned her bachelors at Texas Women's University and her masters at New Mexico State University. Sheri loved working with children and that was what she did for the majority of her career. She worked at various elementary schools, but found the job God created for her at the Oklahoma School for the Deaf. She was able to use her skills as an interpreter for the deaf as well as her degree in speech pathology to serve her students. She worked in home health before going to work as a speech pathologist at OSD. She attended Crossway Baptist Church. She had lived in Sulphur the past 5 years.
