Funeral Services for Stanley Wayne Strang, 45, of Tishomingo will be held on Thursday, May 27, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. at the Church of the Nazarene in Tishomingo with Rev.'s Chad Townsley, Dick Sowder and Dwight Campbell officiating.
