Funeral Services for Mr. Terry Douglas Ragan, 52, of Fillmore, Oklahoma will be held on Thursday, January 19th, 2012 at 10:00 a. m. in the Fillmore Church of the Nazarene with Rev. Eugene Ledford officiating, assisted by Brother Allen Beck and Brother Clint Freeman. Interment will follow at the R & R Farms, south of Milburn, Oklahoma. Mr. Ragan passed away on January 15th, in Fillmore.

Terry was born on November 14th, 1959 in Ada, Oklahoma to Ralph Douglas Ragan and Joye Callen Ragan. He graduated from Milburn High School in 1978 and Southeastern Oklahoma State University in Durant, Oklahoma in 1981. Terry worked as an educator, insurance agent and in farming and ranching, all of his life.
