Funeral Services for Mrs. Thelma G. LaFevers, 100, of Milburn, Oklahoma will be held on Monday, July 15th, 2013 at 10:00 a. m. at the First Baptist Church in Milburn with Rev. Thelma was born on June 9th, 1913 in Milburn to John Wesley Goodman and Ida Lillian (Little) Goodman. She attended school there and later married William Harlin "Dick" LaFevers on January 25th, 1934 in Fillmore, Oklahoma. Except for a short time, Mrs. LaFevers lived in Milburn her entire life. She worked for many years as a cook for the Milburn School and also did a lot of baby sitting for children in the area, while raising her own children.
