Elmer Thomas "Tom" Carr, a resident of Sulphur was born April 7, 1929 in Sulphur, Oklahoma to Elmer George & Vesta Jewell (Mink) Carr. He passed away Wednesday October 21, 2015 at Sulphur, Oklahoma at the age of 86 years 6 months and 14 days.

He had lived in Sulphur most of his life, graduating from Sulphur High School in May 1947. In January 1951 he joined the Navy for 4 years and served during the Korean (Conflict) War stationed on Guam for 19 months and later on board a heavy repair ship/secondary supply ship, the "USS Jason, ARH1", completing his tour of duty December 7, 1954.

Tom and Anita Summers were married on June 2, 1956 at the First Baptist Church in Sulphur, OK.

He worked for Lone Star Gas and was later hired by Platt National Park now the Chickasaw National Recreation Area where he retired after a 30 year career.

He was a member of the American Legion Post #148, Masonic Grand Lodge of OK A.F. Sulphur #144

He was a faithful member and Deacon of Dolberg Missionary Baptist Church until his illness.

He served on the board of Victory Children's Home orphanage and later was president of that board. He was church committeeman to local, state, and National associations. He served a term on National Association Financial Committee.
