



Tom Houston Horton

July 21, 1943 - December 10, 2008

Tom Horton, a resident of Wynnewood, OK was born July 21, 1943 in Wichita Falls, Texas to Seleta (Foulks) and Connor Horton. He passed away December 10, 2008 at the age of 65 years 4 months and 19 days. He was married to Sue (Dowdy) Horton at Rule, Texas on August 15, 1963. He attended Texas Tech University where he received his Bachelor's degree and went on to receive his Master's degree in 1965. Mr. Horton moved to Wynnewood from Post, Texas in 1971 and spent the rest of his life in Wynnewood. When Mr. Horton moved to Wynnewood in 1971 he began his career as the FFA teacher and gave his life to his students until his retirement in 1994. After his retirement he worked for Shannon Sharp in Pauls Valley at ProAg. He was a member of First United Methodist in Wynnewood. He was also a 32nd degree Mason and member of the Eastern Star. He was preceded in death by his Parents, Brother - Connor Lynn Horton (at the age of 4), and Brother - Larry Joe Horton in 1980.
