“ The world is a lesser place without Truman Harris. He was always kind and good to us, people he didn't even know, from the very moment that we moved in as neighbors in 2006. We would not be in our house were it not for his help (and that of his wife, Betty), as well as the our other amazing neighbors (including Kent and Shari Harris, Truman's son and daughter-in-law), who showed up one Sunday afternoon to help us raise it. I'm pretty sure Truman wired the whole house, and put in the septic and the storm shelter! He would stop over on a regular basis, sometimes to help Steve or watch me riding a horse, and he was always happy to sit and visit either in the driveway or at the kitchen table. He always brought feed caps over for our son and daughter, Caleb and Gabrielle, who love him dearly, and he would only occasionally take a dozen eggs in return (usually he'd slip the kids a couple dollars instead). He really liked my homemade rolls. I think I once saw him eat a half dozen while sitting at the table. We saw him last week in the hospital, but he was sleeping comfortably and we didn't want to wake him; I prefer to remember the last time I saw him before Christmas when he drove over to check on the progress of the new house we are building; we talked about how the siding was coming and where to put the steps. He lamented not being a younger man, because if he was, "I'd help Steve get that done." I told him, "Mr. Harris, if we had those steps up, you'd be in there right now!" I think he would have remarked on how windy it was today, but enjoyed the sunshine and the red bud trees in bloom. We are so grateful for his friendship. We will miss him very much. Our deepest sympathies to his family.
