



## Vernon Lois (Tribble) Woodard

September 6, 1925 - October 7, 2014

Funeral Services for Ms. Vernon Lois Tribble Woodard, 89, of Tishomingo, Oklahoma will be held on Saturday, October 11th, 2014 at 1:00 pm, in the Herb Clark Memorial Chapel at Clark Funeral Service with Rev.
