



Vernon (Mac) McArthur Boyce

December 1, 1918 - November 25, 2004

Mac was born in Batesville, Arkansas to Lee & Alma Baxter Boyce. He died Thursday Nov. 25, in Houston, Texas,

He came to Oklahoma as a small child and settled with his family on a farm near Elmore City. He graduated from Elmore City High School in 1934. He joined the US Navy in 1942. His tour of duty took him to Navy Pier in Chicago, where he met Genevieve F. Kobak. They were married September 11, 1943 at the Jacksonville Naval Air Station in Jacksonville, Florida. He trained as an aircraft mechanic and served on the USS Guadalcanal, and the USS Ranger. After his discharge from the Navy he bought a farm in the Joy- Wynnewood area and moved there in 1950. In December 2000 they moved to Sugarland, Texas to be near their daughter & grandchildren He was a member of St. Francis Xavier Catholic Church.
