Funeral Services for Ms. Fay May, 76, of Tishomingo, Oklahoma will be held on Wednesday, July 24th, 2013 at 1:00 p. m. at the First Baptist Church with Mr. Van Newton officiating, assisted by Rev. Luke Holmes. Interment will follow in the Russett Cemetery. Ms. May passed away on July 20th, 2013 at the Denton Regional Hospital in Denton, Texas.

Fay was born on June 21st, 1937 in Hendrix, Oklahoma to Delno Arthur Covington and Grace Bell (Allen) Covington. She graduated from high school at Russett and later married Tommy Sylvester May on December 15th, 1955 in Ardmore, Oklahoma. Fay worked at the Murray State College Daycare for a short time and then as a deputy clerk in the Johnston County Clerk's office, retiring with 20 plus years of service. She was also a longtime member of the First Baptist Church in Tishomingo.
