Wayland Woodrow "Woody" Elmore, a resident of Stratford, OK, was born on December 24, 1942 in Stratford, OK to Ernie Estelle (McKnight) and Lester Woodrow Elmore.

Woody passed away at home in Stratford on October 8, 2024 at the age of 81.

Woodrow grew up and attended school in Stratford where he graduated in 1960. Shortly after,

he joined the United States Army and served for right over 3 years. While in the Army, most of

his time of service was in Germany where he was promoted to Sergeant, he earned his infantryman's badge, and he was the gunner on a 105-millimeter gun. After he returned home

from serving his country, he married Nelda Wood and together raised their family in Stratford.

Woodrow supported his boys' showing livestock, playing football and baseball, and participating

in the Stratford Round Up Club. Woodrow worked for many years in the oil industry for Dowell

and Dresser Titan as a Safety and Driver's Trainer. In 1986, Woodrow married Patsy Lawson/Savage. Woodrow also worked for the City of Stratford and the Stratford Housing Authority before he became co-owner of Wood's Tire Shop. Woodrow operated the tire shop for

about 4 years before he finally retired. During retirement, Woodrow enjoyed taking care of animals, fishing, and reading many, many books.
