Love from your forever friends in Bandera, Texas for life!

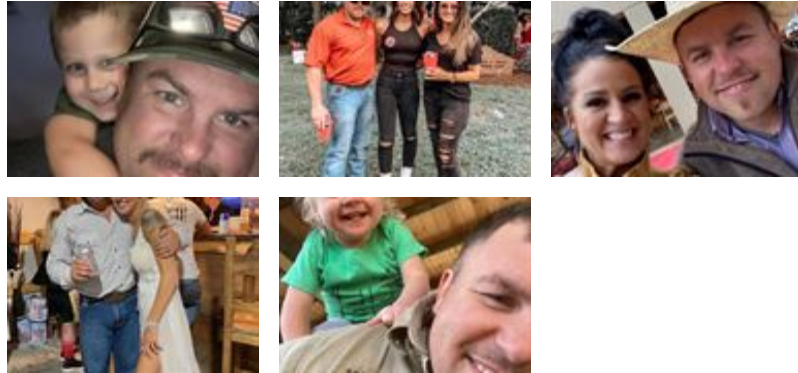
