Willis Fulsom Vandagriff, a resident of Sulphur was born July 1, 1929 in Galveston, TX to Mary Elizabeth Burgevin and Carl Raymond Vandagriff. 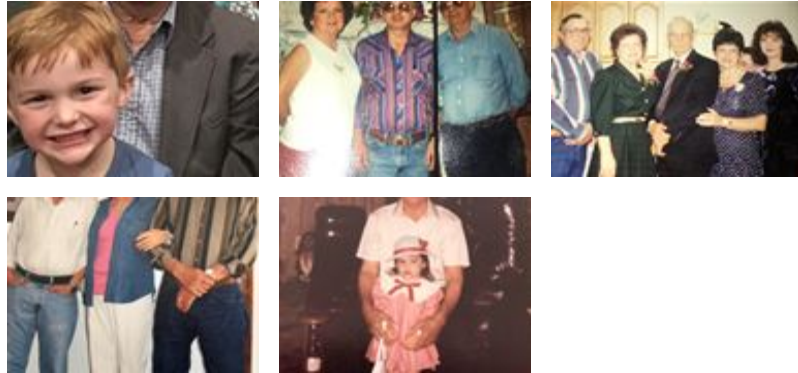
