Yvonne K. Gowan, a resident of Sulphur was born March 12, 1911 in Cookville, Texas to John A. & Elma (Myers) Keith. She passed away Thursday November 29, 2012 at Sulphur, Oklahoma at the age of 101 years 8 months and 17 days. She was married to Robert L. Gowan at Ardmore, OK on June 21, 1935. He preceded her in death November 6, 1986. She moved to Sulphur as a teenager; and graduated from Sulphur High School in 1927. She received her BA in Education from East Central State Teachers College in 1938. She taught at OSD for 34 years. She taught airplane mechanics to the deaf in Chickasha. She was a member of First Baptist Church where she had taught a Deaf Sunday School Class. She served as the first female on the City Council and was serving on the council when the Lake of the Arbuckles was built. She was a member of Chamber of Commerce, B.& P.W. She was preceded in death by her parents and a brother Frank Keith.
